Benefits of Writing for Publication to CEMASTEA and Authors

Introduction

This annex describes the benefits of writing for publication to CEMASTEA and the authors. It has two main sections, Section A which describes the benefits of writing papers and Section B which describes the benefits of writing books to both CEMASTEA and the authors. You are encouraged to read it before you submit the form on authority to write (Annex IV). Feel free to seek for clarification where necessary.

Section A: Benefits of writing papers

1. CEMASTEA

An important benefit to CEMASTEA of writing papers for publication using CEMASTEA's data/information is publicity. In this regard all authors are required to acknowledge CEMASTEA in providing data or information used to write papers. To enforce this all papers written must bear the statement shown in the endnote¹ on the first page of the paper prior to submitting them for publication. It is the duty of the author to convince the publisher to include this statement preferably on the first page of the published paper.

2. Author

Many promotions especially in the academia world require that the interviewee must have published some papers in peer-reviewed journals. The main benefit for writing papers for publication using CEMASTEA's data/information to individual authors is their professional growth since the published papers will count towards their CVs.

Section B: Benefits of writing Books

- 1. CEMASTEA
- Just like the papers written for publication, books written using CEMASTEA's data/information will bear the statement in the end note preferably on the copyright page of the book for publicity of CEMASTEA.
- In addition, royalties arising from the sale of the book will be shared between CEMASTEA and the authors in the ratio of 1:9 and 1:5:4 between CEMASTEA, authors of book chapters and book editors for edited books.
- At least two books will be donated by the authors and/or editors to CEMASTEA's Library.

2. Author

Besides, the professional growth and improvement of the authors' CVs as a result of writing books for publication, royalties arising from the sale of the book will be shared between
